
Reminder: Submissions for ELIP 2021 are due December 10th

How to set up an OJS Account:

- 1. Go to ELIP's OJS website (ojs.lib.uwo.ca/index.php/elip)
- 2. Register for an OJS account (the "Register" button is in the top right corner).
- 3. Click on the "Make a Submission" button and follow the instructions.





- Research Articles and Critical Essays (3000-6000 words): Transform your course papers or assignments into journal articles. If you're unsure about how to do this, talk to Lisa or your course instructors.
- In the Field (2000 words max): Have you gone on a co-op? Maybe you already have an LIS related job? Write a short piece to tell us about your experience.
- For the Field (2000 words max): Are you involved in a student group doing interesting LIS related work? Did you do a project on a practical issue that would be of interest to LIS professionals? Share your knowledge and experiences!
- Interviews (750 words max): Have you interviewed an LIS professional for a course assignment? Is there someone in the field whose career path intrigues you? Interviews are a great way to make professional connections and learn about different areas within LIS.
- Reviews (750 words max): Have you read a new LIS related book for a class? Write a short review! The FIMS Graduate Library has all kinds of new materials (books, games, makerspace materials etc.) that can be reviewed. Contact Lisa for a list of interesting new titles.
