2009 MASTER OF LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SCIENCE PLACEMENT SURVEY



SUMMARY

Of the 182 students who graduated from the Master of Library and Information Science program in 2009, 78 completed the placement survey. This represents an overall response rate of 43%.

Note: The majority of statistics which follow in this report (e.g. type of employment, location, etc.) pertain to those respondents who reported finding employment.

Placement Rate

Of the 78 respondents, 62 reported finding employment. This represents a 79% placement rate. Of those employed, (72%) have secured a position related to their MLIS degree. Over two third of the employed respondents obtained full-time employment (69%), including 32 people who are in permanent positions.

Salary

The responding graduates holding full-time positions reported an annual salary range from \$29,800 to \$68,000. The median full-time salary was \$52,500.

Types of Placement and Job Assignment

Positions were offered in many different types of organizations with the most common being public libraries (27%) and university / college libraries (23%). The primary job assignment reported most often was reference / information services (32%), with specified other primary job assignments being second at 17%.

Skill or Knowledge Most Influential in Securing Employment

This year, 33 respondents participated in the MLIS Co-op Program during their studies (42%). Of the employed respondents, 42% identified their co-op experience as most helpful in securing employment. Technological skills and type of library environment both tied at 16% each.

Length of Job Search

Approximately 36% of the employed respondents reported securing employment prior of their graduation and 30% found employment in less than three months after graduation. An additional 25% reported receiving employment within three to six months. Altogether, up to 91% of respondents had obtained LIS employment within 6 months of graduation.

Location of Placement

Most employed respondents reported being employed within Canada, with the majority of positions located in Ontario (66%).










