2013 MASTER OF LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SCIENCE PLACEMENT SURVEY



SUMMARY

A total of 144 students graduated from the Master of Library and Information Science program in 2013. Of those graduates, 46 completed the placement survey. This represents an overall response rate of 32%.

Note: The majority of statistics which follow in this report (e.g. type of employment, location, etc.) pertain to those respondents who reported finding employment.

Placement Rate

Of the 46 respondents, 40 reported finding employment. This represents a 87% placement rate. Of those employed, 83% have secured a position related to their MLIS degree. Of the 33 respondents with employment related to their MLIS degree, over three quarter obtained full-time employment (85%), including 20 people who are in permanent positions.

Salary

The responding graduates holding full-time positions reported an annual salary range from \$31,000 to \$90,000. The median full-time salary was \$50,000.

Types of Placement and Job Assignment

Positions were offered in many different types of organizations with the most common being public libraries (45%) and university / college libraries (30%). The primary job assignment reported most often was reference / information services (36%), with youth and children's services being second at 21%.

Skill or Knowledge Most Influential in Securing Employment

This year, 16 respondents had participated in the MLIS Co-op Program during their studies (40%). Of the employed respondents, 45% identified their co-op experience as most helpful in securing employment. Type of library environment, subject specialization and management, marketing, communication skills were also influential factors at 13% each.

Length of Job Search

Approximately one third of the employed respondents reported securing employment prior of their graduation and 36% found employment in less than three months after graduation. An additional 12% reported receiving employment within three to six months. Altogether, up to 82% of respondents had obtained LIS employment within 6 months of graduation.

Location of Placement

Most employed respondents reported being employed within Canada, with the majority of positions located in Ontario (58%).












