2020 MASTER OF LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SCIENCE PLACEMENT SURVEY



SUMMARY

A total of 120 students graduated from the Master of Library and Information Science program in 2020. Of those graduates, 21 completed the placement survey. This represents an overall response rate of 5.7%.

Note: The majority of statistics that follow in this report (e.g. type of employment, location, etc.) pertain to those respondents who reported finding employment related to their MLIS degree.

Placement Rate

Of the 21 respondents, 17 reported finding employment. This represents 81% placement rate. Of those employed, 71% have secured a position related to their MLIS degree. Of the 21 respondents with employment related to their MLIS degree, over half obtained **full-time employment** (62%), including 7 people who are in **permanent positions.**

Salary

The responding graduates holding full-time positions related to their MLIS degree reported an **annual salary range** from \$45,000 to \$65,000. The average full-time salary was \$56,000.

Types of Placement and Job Assignment

Positions were obtained in many different types of organizations with the most common being Government libraries (29%) and Public libraries (18%). The primary job / assignment reported most often was Records and Information Management (35%), followed by References and Information Services (24%) and Research and Consultation (24%).

Skill or Knowledge Most Influential in Securing Employment

This year, 15 of the 21 respondents (71%) with employment related to their MLIS degree participated in the MLIS Co-op Program during their studies. Nearly half of the respondents also identified co-op or practicum experience as most helpful in securing their first job (43%).

Length of Job Search

Of the 21 respondents employed in various LIS related fields, 24% of the respondents reported securing employment before graduation. An additional 48% indicated that they found employment in less than three months after graduation. Altogether, 71% of the respondents were engaged in LIS employment within 6 months of graduation.

Location of Placement

All respondents reported being employed within Canada, with the majority of positions located in Ontario (73%).


What is your current employment status?







10. What is the ONE area of knowledge / skill you've acquired while in your MLIS program that you considered most helpful in securing your first job?


